

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

SUPREME COURT

In Case No. 2008-0897, Appeal of Stonyfield Farm, Inc. & a., the court on April 20, 2009, issued the following order:

TransCanada Hydro Northeast, Inc.'s assented-to motion for leave to appear as *amicus curiae* is granted. Campaign for Ratepayers Rights, Clean Water Action, Conservation Law Foundation, New Hampshire Sierra Club, Resident's Environmental Action Committee for Health, and Union of Concerned Scientists' motion for leave to file *amicus curiae* brief is granted.

Public Service Company of New Hampshire's motion to strike *amicus curiae* brief is denied. Motion for permission to file reply to objection to motion for leave to file *amicus curiae* brief is moot.

TransCanada Hydro Northeast, Inc. has requested five minutes oral argument time and Campaign for Ratepayers Rights, Clean Water Action, Conservation Law Foundation, New Hampshire Sierra Club, Resident's Environmental Action Committee for Health, and Union of Concerned Scientists have requested fifteen minutes oral argument time. On or before April 30, 2009, the appellants shall inform the court whether they wish to cede any portion of their fifteen minutes of oral argument time to either *amicus*.

This order is entered by a single justice (Duggan, J.). See Rule 21(7).
